Our highest paid position

You are paid for each job you work. Your pay is based on an hourly rate for the <u>time allocation expected to</u> <u>complete the job</u>. This is like compensation plans for mechanics. If you complete the job early, you still get paid the full amount based on the time allocation. If you go over time, you only get paid the allocation of time. <u>This is technically a commission paid job</u>. We don't pay for drive time unless your average drive exceeds 30 minutes. If the average drive time happens to go over 30 minutes, we pay your hourly cleaning rate for the excess drive time.

Example Chart of Pay based on hours cleaned a week. Tax Rates can vary based on deductions and filing status. This chart is an example and not a guarantee. You typically get 30 hours of cleaning a week, but it may be slightly less or more, but no less than 25 hours, unless you take time off.
